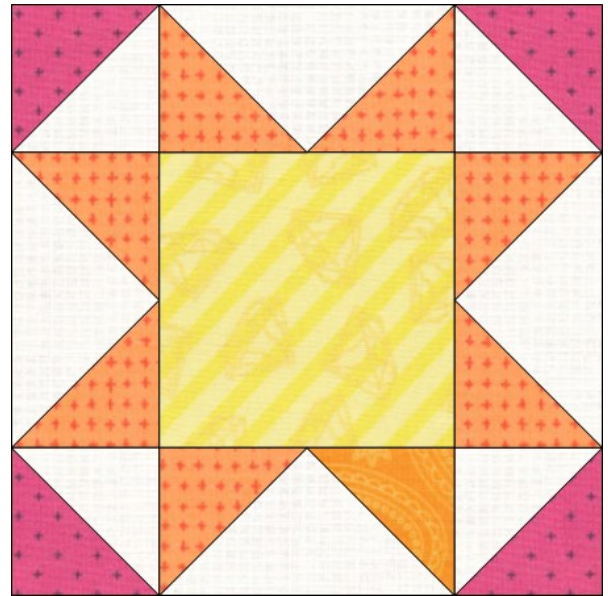


### Supplies for Sunny Star and Butterfly blocks

- 1/8 yard each (or large scraps) of yellow, orange and magenta fabric for the Sunny Stars
- Large scraps of green, light purple, dark purple and black for the Butterfly block
- 1/4 yard (or fat quarter) of background fabric for the Sunny Star and Butterfly blocks
- Wing Clipper trim down tool for Flying Geese Units (optional)

**Note:** Please read all instructions before beginning this project. All seams are made using a 1/4" seam allowance.



### Sunny Star Block, 6 1/2" unfinished

#### Cutting Instructions (for 2 blocks)

- Yellow: Cut (2) 3 1/2" squares (center square)
- Orange: Cut (8) 2 5/8" squares (over-sized for flying geese)
- Magenta: Cut (1) 5" square (HST's)
- White: Cut (1) 5" square, (2) 4 1/2" squares (over-sized for flying geese)

#### Assembly Instructions

##### Half-square triangle units

1. Draw a diagonal line in both directions on the white 5" square. (Figure 1)
2. Place a marked 5" white square, right sides together, with a 5" magenta square. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the diagonal lines. (Figure 2) Cut apart on the center diagonal lines and then cut the square in half vertically and horizontally. (Figure 3)
3. Press towards the magenta fabric. (Figure 4)
4. Trim all 8 HST's to 2" square using a square ruler. (Figure 5)

##### Flying Geese Units (almost no-waste method)

5. Draw a diagonal line on the orange 2 5/8" squares. (Figure 6)
6. With right sides together, place an orange square on two opposite corners of a white 4 1/2" square. (Figure 7)
7. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. (Figure 8)
8. Cut apart on the center diagonal line. (Figure 9)
9. Press towards the orange. (Figure 10)
10. Place the remaining orange 2 5/8" squares on the opposite corner of above unit and stitch 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. (Fig. 11)
11. Cut apart on the center drawn line. Press towards the orange. You will have four flying geese units that **need to be trimmed to 2" x 3 1/2"**. (Figure 12) For trimming instructions, go to <http://thecraftyquilter.com/2018/06/summer-fun-quilt-along-week-4/>

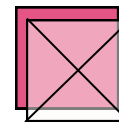

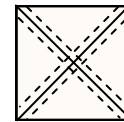

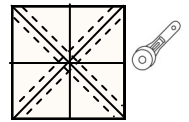

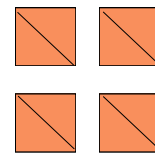

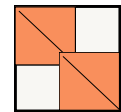

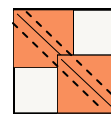

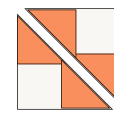

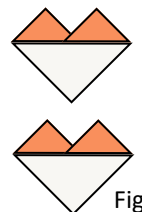

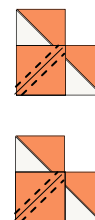

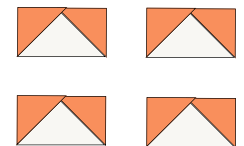

## Sunny Star Final Assembly

12. Arrange the HST's, flying geese units and yellow  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown in Figure 13.
13. Sew them into rows. Press the center row to the middle and the top and bottom rows to the outside. (Figure 14)
14. Sew the rows together. Press towards the center. (Fig. 15)
15. Make 2 blocks.

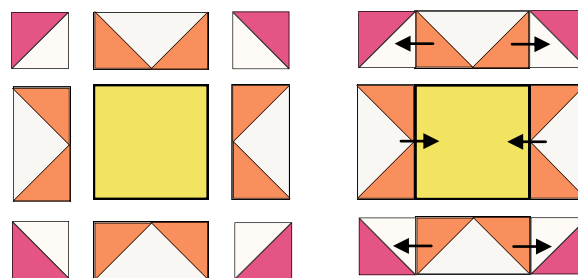

## Butterfly Block, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished

### Cutting instructions

- Light purple: Cut (2)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
- Dark purple: Cut (2)  $2$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles
- Green: Cut (2)  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles, (2)  $1\frac{5}{8}$ " squares, (1)  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " square
- Black: Cut (1)  $1$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangle
- Background: Cut (2)  $2$ " squares, (1)  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " square, (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, (1)  $1$ " x  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle, (1)  $1$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, (2)  $1$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, (2)  $1$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

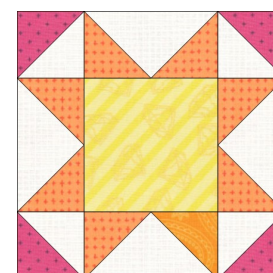
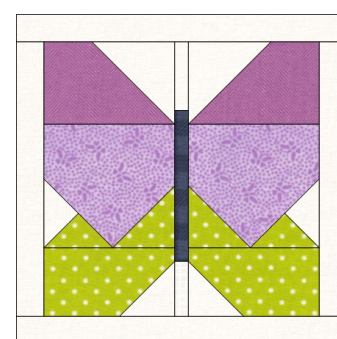

### Butterfly Block Assembly Instructions

16. Draw a diagonal line on the following pieces: green  $1\frac{5}{8}$ " squares, white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, white  $2$ " squares, and white  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " square. (Figure 13)

With right sides together, place a (Figure 14)

- $2$ " white square on each dark purple rectangle, mirror imaging each other
  - $1\frac{5}{8}$ " green square onto the lower corner of each light purple square, mirror imaging each other
  - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white square onto the lower corner of each green rectangle, mirror imaging each other
  - $2\frac{1}{4}$ " white square onto a  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " green square
17. For the  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " green and white squares, stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal line to create two half-square triangle units. (Figure 15)
  18. Cut on the diagonal line and press towards the green. (Figure 16)
  19. Trim the half-square triangle (HST) units to  $1\frac{5}{8}$ " square. (Figure 17)
  20. Draw a diagonal line on each  $1\frac{5}{8}$ " HST that is perpendicular to the seam. (Figure 17)
  21. For the remaining squares, stitch on the diagonal lines, trim the seam allowances and press to the corners. (Figure 18)
  22. Place each marked  $1\frac{5}{8}$ " HST unit to the remaining lower corner of each light purple unit. Stitch on the drawn line. (Figure 19)
  23. Trim and press to the corner. (Figure 20)

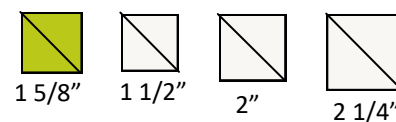

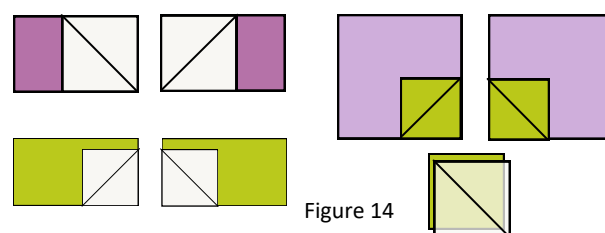

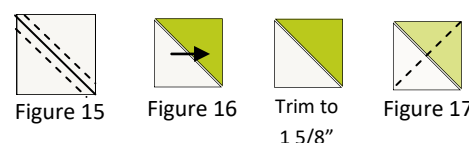

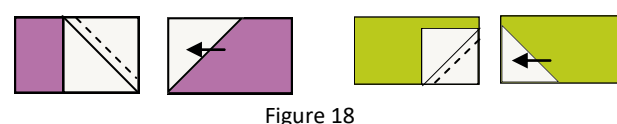

## Week 4

### Butterfly Block Assembly Instructions (continued)

24. Arrange the upper, middle and lower butterfly units and the butterfly center pieces as shown in (Figure 21).
25. Stitch the wing units and the center units together. Press the wing units down and the center units toward the black.
26. Sew the wing units to the center butterfly unit. It should measure 5 1/2" square. (Figure 23)
27. Add the white 1" x 5 1/2" border strips and then the 1" x 6 1/2" border strips. (Figure 24)

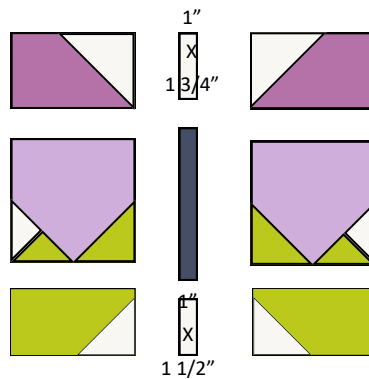

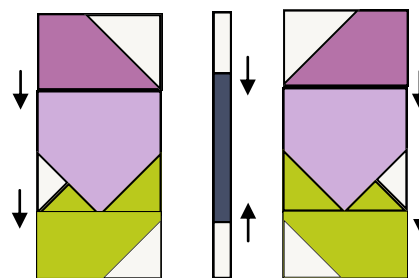

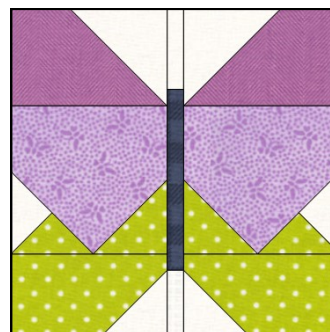

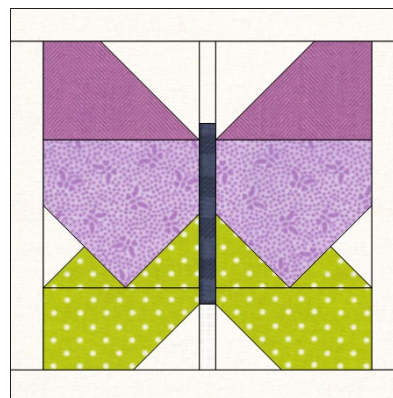
