

THE CRAFTY QUILTER PRESENTS



This 16" pillow will warm your heart as well as your home!

Supplies:

- 16" Pillow Form
- Fabric Scraps for house
- 1 fat quarter for backing
- 1 fat quarter for borders
- 1/4 yard binding (optional)
- 1 1/4" zipper (optional)
- Fusible fleece or batting

Cutting Instructions:

House fabric:

- (1) 4 1/2" square
- (1) 3 1/2" x 6"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 4"
- (4) 1 1/2" squares
- (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- (2) 2 1/2" squares

Red fabric:

- (1) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- (2) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Roof fabric:

- (1) 3" x 10 1/2"

Chimney fabric:

- (1) 1 1/2" square

Sky fabric:

- 3" squares
- (2) 1 1/2" x 3"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 7"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 5"
- (2) 2" x 7 1/2"

Grass fabric:

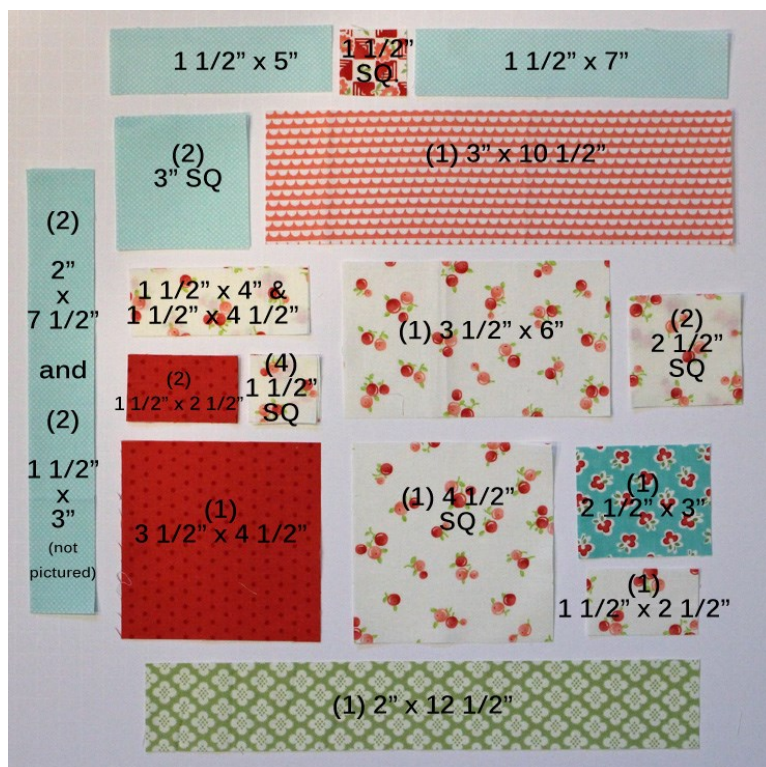
- (1) 2" x 12 1/2"

Window fabric:

- (1) 2 1/2" x 3"

Borders:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2"
- (2) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2"



Note: All seams are 1/4". Press seams as desired. Some pressing instructions are included.

Roof Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 3" square of sky fabric. Pin to each end of the roof piece and stitch on the diagonal line. Trim seam and press.



Stitch the 1 1/2" x 3" sky rectangles to each side of the roof.

Stitch 1 1/2" x 5" and 1 1/2" x 7" sky rectangles to each side of chimney piece.

Stitch the roof unit to the chimney unit.

Heart Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 2 1/2" square of house fabric. Pin and stitch to lower corners of red 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle. Press and trim seam.

Draw a diagonal line across the 1 1/2" squares of house fabric. Pin and stitch to each end of the red 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles, creating flying geese units.



Stitch the flying geese units together as shown and press seam open. Attach to the top of the heart and press towards large heart body.

This should measure 4 1/2" square.

Assemble lower house: Stitch the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each side of heart. This unit should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Assemble upper house: Stitch the 3 " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " window to the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Next add the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 " rectangle to the top of window unit.

Stitch the 6 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the window unit. This upper house unit should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Stitch the lower half of the house to the upper half of the house.



Assemble the house: Stitch the two 2 " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " sky rectangles to each side of the house.

Stitch the roof unit to the house unit.

Stitch the 2 " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " grass rectangle to the house.

Your house should now measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Attach borders: Stitch the side borders on first. Then add the top and bottom borders.

Create a pillow using your favorite method. I sandwiched the top with fusible fleece and muslin. Then I stitched in the ditch around the main house and added the words, "Home is where the heart is" to the top and bottom borders.

I used [this](#) tutorial to make a covered zipper pillow-back for my pillow.

I also added binding around the outside of the pillow.
