

GLASS HALF FULL MUG RUG

A FREE Pattern By Julie Cefalu

Finished Size: 6" x 9"

Material & Cutting Instructions:

Gray background: 6" x 7" 6 assorted cream squares: 2 1/2" Applique: fabric scraps Backing: 7 1/2" x 10 1/2" Batting: 7 1/2" x 10 1/2" Binding: (1) 2 1/4" x 42" strip



Applique Instructions:


Create the mason jar with flowers using your favorite applique technique. I used raw edge fusible applique for everything but the stems. I used a 1/4" bias tape maker to create the stems. The applique is stitched with a narrow zig zag stitch in matching thread. I used a straight stitch on the stems and continued the stitch into the mason jar. Trim the applique unit to 5 1/2" x 6 1/2".


Piecing Instructions: All seams are 1/4"

Sew the 2 1/2" squares into pairs. Sew the pairs together to create a panel of 2 squares across and 3 squares down. It should measure 4 1/2" x 6 1/2". Stitch this unit to the applique.

Embroidery: Trace the words onto the pieced panel. Embroider with a backstitch and 3 strands of embroidery floss.

Finishing: Layer the backing, batting and top. Baste together. (I used temporary spray adhesive.) Quilt. I free motion stitched around the applique and echoed it once around. I used a walking foot to stitch a grid onto the pieced section. Trim and apply binding.
